Bibliographic references are double-spaced and indented half an inch after the first line. When a DOI is used, no further retrieval information is needed to identify or locate the content. Do not include the database name. It is no longer necessary to include

the date of retrieval unless the source material may change over time (e.g., Wikis).

Article, Journal (with DOI) - APA 6th Edition Citation ...

If a journal article has a DOI, include the DOI in the reference. Always include the issue number for a journal article. If the journal article does not have a DOI and is from an academic research database, end the reference after the page range (for an explanation of why, see the database information page). The reference in this case is the same as for a print journal article.

Reference List. In-text Citation. Basic Format: Last name, A. A. (Year). Title of article. Title of Journal, Volume number (issue number if available), pages. Example: Scruton, R. (1996). The eclipse of listening. *The New Criterion*, 15(3), 5-13. Note: The name of the author is reversed with the last name first followed by the initials.

APA Journal Citation | APA Format

An APA in-text citation consists of the author's last name and the year of publication (also known as the author-date system). If you're citing a specific part of a source, you should also include a locator such as a page number or timestamp. For example: (Smith, 2020, p. 170). Parenthetical vs. narrative citation

Add a comma after the parentheses, and then include the page range of the article (for those articles with designated page numbers on each page of the article). Add a period after the page numbers. Then, add the DOI using the current standard of the DOI, which starts with <https://doi.org/>.

Journal Article - Citation Help for APA, 7th Edition ...

Since URLs can potentially change and DOIs do not, APA journal citation style recommends using a Digital Object Identifier (DOI) instead of a website URL when possible. A DOI in your reference should be formatted as: <https://doi.org/xxxx>; If a source has a DOI, it should be included; it doesn't matter if you viewed the print or online version.

How to Cite a Journal in APA | EasyBib Citations

As of the most recent (8th) edition, MLA encourages students to include the DOI at the end of the citation for an online scholarly journal article. If no DOI exists, use the URL. Author LastName, FirstName, and FirstName LastName.

What is a DOI and how do I use them in citations?

A digital object identifier (DOI) is a unique alphanumeric string assigned by a registration agency (the International DOI Foundation) to identify content and provide a persistent link to its location on the internet. The publisher assigns a DOI when your article is published and made available electronically.
