Dunhuang, a city in Gansu province of northwestern China, was one of the most important stops on the Silk Road. It was a major trade centre and military outpost during the Sui and Tang dynasties (581-907). When Buddhism reached China via the Silk Road, Dunhuang was the first stop for monks arriving from the west.
